



- Reduced SO2 emission 17,000 tons





Case Study: APP Indonesia

INTEGRATED FORESTRY AND FARMING SYSTEM





In 2015, APP launched the Integrated Forestry and Farming System (IFFS), also known as Desa Makmur Peduli Api (DMPA), was developed to mitigate these threats.

In 500 villages in 5 provinces over the next 5 years.

USD 10 million from APP.





Case Study: APP Indonesia

191 villages

have been implemented in IFFS program as of March 2018

25 woman groups

out of 573 farmer groups in 2017.

13,814 households

are benefitting from IFFS program.

IDR 32.21 Billion

have been channelled into the IFFS programs on village level.
